

Extended Project Qualification

Criteria for Acceptance

1. Shown already during Y12 the ability to manage your workload, time, and stress.
2. 90% plus attendance in Y12.
3. Positive tracking; no deadline concerns.
4. Applying to one or more of the following: Oxbridge, medical college, veterinary science college, dentistry, a Russell university, or another prestigious university (e.g. SOAS, York, Bath, East Anglia etc).
However, anyone who can make a logical and coherent case for taking EPQ, will be considered.
5. Completion of a letter outlining: why you want to do EPQ, what makes you think you can cope, what you hope to get from the course, whether you have a broad idea of what you wish to study (or a career plan), and how your project might fit with your area of study at university.

This letter should include a signed, dated recommendation from a teacher/tutor.

The maximum number of students allowed to take EPQ during 2011/12 is 30. The better you letter, the greater your chance!

Your application will be assessed on your response! It should be handed to Helen in the Post 16 Office by Tuesday July 5th at the latest.
